Understanding the Discount



10% of \$5.00=\$.50 Subtract \$.50 from \$5 So you pay \$4.50





You can buy things with money or with a plastic card known as a credit card.

These two cards look almost the same. Can you find what is different?







A credit card allows you to buy things and pay for them later. But you will be charged interest (more money) if you don't pay it back right away.



This little card can be dangerous. It is tempting to buy things and pay for them later. If you owe money and you do not have enough to pay it back, it will cause trouble. Try to use a credit card only for emergencies.



A debit card takes the money you are spending directly from your bank account. You must have money in the bank to use this card!



There is one more kind of card. It is a gift card. You buy a gift card to give to someone for a birthday or holiday. They come in different amounts of money that the person receiving the card will get to spend.



To buy a gift card for someone, you will pay the same amount as the person is receiving on the card.
